-mostly teachers prefer a policy that is easy to manage. Easy means no phones at school, also during break times. Parents have (obviously) very varied opinions, realizing the possible harm to development of social skills with teenagers; some parents also find it important to be able to be in contact with their kids. Total ban can be difficult to organise, it being an open school. The option of a trial month of no phone policy is discussed. After voting on different options, the MR does not reach a consensus on what to advise to management (vote is split between 'keep as is' and 'trial month'). MR will advise management to be clear on communication, whatever is (not) decided

b) Bullying / racism and the protocol (16:55)
