

MR meeting on Monday 30 March 2026

Present: chair, secretary, VO staff, 2 VO students, 3 parents, 1 OOP staff

Absent: 1 PO staff

1. Opening: 16:05

2. Discussion:

This morning we received the latest version of the plans. What is still needed for us to give approval? Chair proposes to decide on Taakbeleid in April, as part of the formatieplan.

For lesson table a proposal for music lessons in PO is discussed and will be shared with management.

3. Management joins at 16:45

4. Meeting notes of 16-02-2026 are discussed and approved.

Principal explains additions to this version of the plan, particularly regarding phase 3 of the process.

Discussion about the lesson table, does MR have approval rights on this? Doubts are clarified.

1. Lesson table:

PO: Agreed is that budget changes are spread likewise over all groups, and not only in lower primary. School aims to get a music teacher from MSA for next year. Also, a music method (e.g. 123zing) will be used to aid teachers and make sure learning goals are covered.

VO changes in lesson table are discussed. Focus will be on Dutch A programme, according to a plan of implementation; this plan will happen over the course of two years at least, perhaps three (w. testing of students to assess readiness).

Other changes are mentioned as in the latest version of the plan. No further questions from MR.

2. Leerlingengroei

Group size increase to 26 is discussed and explained as a choice. Management for the moment will focus on this number and not venture into an increase of groups 1/2 to 28. How will the school manage the growth of the school to 26? Management is hopeful and is taking steps in communication so as to make the school more popular with our target population. Concerns of maintaining the quality of education are addressed. An external 'promotion expert' will assist the school in this.

3. Havo DP

Question on process of phasing out. Different possibilities regarding the timeline are mentioned. Question on curriculum of gr.11/12i and which language the lessons will be in. Management proposes: Gr.11 students with Havo advice will still do the Havo programme. The expectation is that there will be 15 students next year. Also school needs time to prepare IB-programme to Havo level. So, management proposes to stay the course for one more year, with a small Havo group for next year. Agreement from MR means that school will prepare to make the changes, start the communication ecc.

4. Parent contribution

Questions on lack of details of certain plans, e.g. solidarity funds. What are the criteria of this? Also, will school trips be canceled or paid for by parents, and then how much will this fee be? Management clarifies what fees will be asked from parents and when.

5. Budgetteren per vakgroep

6. Taakbeleid

MR will approve on the focus of the school that the Taakbeleid will be better adjusted to fit the formation that is suitable for the size of the school.

The timeline of the next phase of the plan is clarified, concerning in particular the assessment and feedback moments with MR. MR will also receive different policy documents that contain implementation of parts of the plan.

Imelda states the understanding of the need for smaller budgets and supports the general direction, and therefore voted in favour of the proposal. At the same time, Imelda has questions about the underlying assumptions and the way the proposals are worked out. The rector agreed that these questions will be discussed together at a later stage.

MR approves the note on lesson table and on the havo curriculum. PMR approves the note on taakbeleid. OMR approves the note on ouderbijdrage.
